

AN EMERGENCY MEETING WAS CALLED FOR THE GREENFIELD TOWNSHIP TRUSTEES PER JASON DOLIN'S RECOMMENDATION. THE MEETING WAS HELD AT THE GREENFIELD TOWNSHIP OFFICE ON FRIDAY MARCH 25, 2016. THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER AT 10:00 AM. THOSE PRESENT WERE DAVE COTNER AND JOHN REEF. ZONING INSPECTOR, KEVIN YEAMANS WAS ASKED TO BE PRESENT ALSO. TRUSTEE LONNIE KOSCH WAS NOT PRESENT DUE TO BEING OUT OF STATE AT THE TIME.

ON MARCH 24, 2016, JOHN REEF CONTACTED JASON DOLIN ABOUT THE ROCKMILL BREWERY NOTIFICATION TIMES OF THE HEARING CONTINUANCE FOR THE PUD. AT APPROXIMATELY 8:00 AM ON MARCH 25TH JASON DOLIN WENT OVER THE EMAIL SENT HIM BY JOHN REEF AND ASKED JOHN TO CALL HIM TO CLARIFY VARIOUS FACTS ON THE MATTER. AT THAT TIME HIS VERBAL RECOMMENDATION WAS FOR THE TRUSTEES TO CONTACT ROCKMILL BREWERY APPLICANTS AND THEIR ATTORNEY AS SOON AS POSSIBLE TO SEE IF THEY AGREED TO CONTINUE THE HEARING EVEN THOUGH THE NOTICES WERE NOT SENT IN THE PROPER TIME FRAME AS REQUIRED BY THE ORC. SINCE THERE WAS ONLY ONE FULL WORKING DAY BEFORE THE HEARING CONTINUANCE, JOHN CALLED THE EMERGENCY MEETING PER JASON DOLIN'S RECOMMENDATION. THEY CONTACTED THE ATTORNEY FOR ROCKMILL BREWERY, JEFF BROWN, AND SPOKE TO HIM PER SPEAKER PHONE FROM THE ZONING INSPECTOR'S DESK. MR. BROWN SAID HE HAD NO PROBLEM WITH CONTINUING THE HEARING AS SCHEDULED. ALSO, TRUSTEE COTNER CONTACTED CONTIGUOUS LAND OWNERS (WHO HAD ATTENDED THE FIRST PART OF THE HEARING) BY TELEPHONE TO MAKE SURE THEY KNEW ABOUT THE HEARING CONTINUANCE ON MARCH 29, 2016.

JOHN REEF MOVED TO ADJOURN THE EMERGENCY MEETING. DAVE COTNER SECONDED. ALL VOTED YES. MEETING ADJOURNED
