After discussion, Trustee Searle asked Caitlin to provide all the documentation to the Board so they can address the issue. Caitlin also asked whether the landowners need to attend the Trustee meeting. Trustee Searle noted they are welcome, but it is not necessary that they attend.

Trustee Cotner noted he had made three phone calls to Mr. Baumgardt but there was no answer. He has also made three phone calls to Becky Fisher with no answer.

Zoning Inspector Barbee stated she had spoken with the Health Department regarding the Fisher property, and that process will be moving forward, although it will take quite some time.
